Mile Square Regional Park (<i>16801 Euclid St, Fountain Valley</i>) Greater White-fronted Goose, Vermilion Flycatcher (2), Plumbeous Vireo, Golden-crowned Kinglet, Western Flycatcher, Least/Dusky Flycatcher.
Harriet Wieder Regional Park (<i>19251 Seapoint St, Huntington Beach</i>) American Redstart, Black-and-white Warbler, Virginia Rail.
Bolsa Chica Ecological Reserve (<i>3842 Warner Avenue, Huntington Beach</i>) Reddish Egrets (3), Greater Scaup, Elegant Tern, American Bittern, Clapper Rail, Loggerhead Shrike, Burrowing Owl, Large-billed Savannah Sparrow, Fox Sparrow, Ross's Goose.
Urban Forest (<i>North of Ellis Avenue between Goldenwest and Edwards Streets, Huntington Beach</i>) Gray Flycatcher
Clegg-Stacey Park (<i>between Springdale, Bolsa & Edwards, Huntington Beach</i>) Ross's Goose
John Baca Park (<i>7329 Sherwood Drive, Huntington Beach</i>) Plumbeous Vireo
Lower Santa Ana River Reddish Egrets (2), Pacific Golden-Plover, Canvasbacks, Common Goldeneyes
Orange Coast College Community Garden (<i>Costa Mesa – tucked into the college campus</i>) Palm Warbler, Gray Flycatcher.
Yorba Regional Park (<i>7600 E La Palma Ave, Anaheim</i>) Varied Thrush, American Redstart
Tri-City Park (<i>2301 N. Kraemer Blvd, Placentia</i>) Cackling goose, Aleutian Goose, Hammond's Flycatcher
Craig Regional Park (<i>3300 S. State College Blvd, Fullerton</i>) Snow Goose
Fairhaven Cemetery (Memorial Park) (<i>1702 E Fairhaven Ave, Santa Ana</i>) Cassin's Vireo
Irvine Regional Park (<i>1 Irvine Park Rd, Orange</i>) Mountain Bluebird, Spotted Dove
Upper Newport Bay (<i>often seen on the east side near the Back Bay Science Center</i>) Little Blue Heron
UCI Campus & Vicinity (<i>enter from Campus Drive, Irvine</i>) Black-and-white Warbler, Golden-crowned Kinglet, Red-naped Sapsucker, Hermit Warbler, Yellow Warbler
Mason Regional Park (<i>18712 University Dr, Irvine</i>) Greater White-fronted Goose, Bullock's Oriole
Heritage Park (<i>14341 Yale Ave - corner Yale & Walnut - Irvine</i>) Hooded Merganser, Tricolored Blackbird

Rancho Santa Margarita Lake (<i>21472 Avenida De Los Fundadores, just off Santa Margarita Pkwy</i>) Common Mergansers
Russell Cook Park (<i>31506 Calle Arroyo, San Juan Capistrano</i>) Chestnut-sided Warbler
Dana Point Library (<i>33841 Niguel Rd, Dana Point</i>) Summer Tanager
San Mateo Campground (<i>San Clemente</i>) Red-naped Sapsucker
Aliso Creek (<i>near Aliso Creek Rd bridge – upstream from bridge</i>) Hooded Merganser
Dana Point (<i>2 locations: Dana Point jetty & Doheny State Beach</i>) Black Oystercatcher
Aliso-Wood Canyons Wilderness Park (<i>28373 Alicia Parkway Laguna Niguel</i>) Loggerhead Shrike – on hawk perch across from AZ crossing
