Golden-crowned Kinglet	HCP – west side near frisbie course
Greater Scaup	HCP, Inner Bolsa
Summer Tanager	HCP (Huntington Central Park)

Eurasian Wigeon	HB - Carr Park
Red-breasted Sapsucker	HB - Clegg-Stacey Park
Hooded Merganser	HB - Springdale flood control channel along Bolsa Ave.
Reddish Egret	Bolsa Chica
Ross' Goose	Bolsa Chica – full tidal south
White-winged Scoter	Bolsa Chica – full tidal south
Burrowing Owl	Bolsa Chica – just below heliport in back & muted tidal in back
American Bittern	Bolsa Chica – near boardwalk
Merlin	Bolsa Chica – near Warner
Savannah Sparrow (Large-billed)	Bolsa Chica – on loop trail past boardwalk
Winter Wren	Bolsa Chica – on mesa, near benches above tidal gates
Short-eared Owl	Bolsa Chica – seen on Rabbit Island at 5 pm on 12/30
Hooded Merganser	Bolsa Chica – south end of inner bay
Green-tailed Towhee	Bolsa Chica – seen during count week
Pacific-Golden Plover	Bolsa Chica – full tidal
Lesser Yellowlegs	Bolsa Chica – Rabbit Island
Common Goldeneye	Bolsa Chica – inner Bolsa
American Redstart	MSP – SW area, trees on golf course at fence near soccer field, near Warner
Baltimore Oriole	MSP – near natural area in red flowering Eucalyptus (count week)
Peregrine Falcon	MSP – west central
Nashville Warbler	Costa Mesa Golf Course, south side
Burrowing Owl	Costa Mesa - Fairview Park north of parking lot, in large, flat, plowed field
Yellow Warbler	Environmental Nature Center, NB
American Redstart	Environmental Nature Center, NB
Common Merganser	UNB – Big Canyon (Cattle Egret also seen in this area)
Lesser Yellowlegs	UNB – marker #5, and marker #12
Least Bittern	UNB – near road marker # 23
Sage Sparrow	UNB – Big Canyon
Snow Goose	UNB – channel near Muth Center
Burrowing Owl	UNB – near Muth Center
Common Merganser	UNB – Big Canyon (Cattle Egret also seen in this area)

Short-eared Owl *	UNB – Either the bird was seen before sunrise or just before dusk when it becomes active, feeding over the salt marsh between the boardwalk area below Muth Center (west side of UNB) and the overlook at the old salt dike (off Back Bay Drive, east side of UNB).
American Bittern	San Joaquin Wildlife Sanctuary
Vermilion Flycatcher	SJWS
Least Bittern	SJWS – between ponds 1 & 2
Barn Swallow	SJWS – flying over ponds 1-5 and over UCI Marsh
N. Rough-winged Swallow	SJWS – flying over ponds 1-5 and over UCI Marsh
Phainopepla	SJWS – in sycamore near Audubon House in parking lot
Northern Waterthrush	SJWS – in old existing riparian area (info from Bird Board at SJWS)
Clay-colored Sparrow	SJWS – NE end of pond C, area near fence
Gray Flycatcher	SJWS – NE end of pond C, area near fence
Summer Tanager	UCI – Aldrich parking lot
Palm Warbler	UCI – dorms
Ferruginous Hawk	Tustin - blimp base south side near Barranca Parkway
Rock Wren	Sepulveda Vista Point at the end of Federation Way in Irvine
N. Rough-winged Swallow	Offshoot of Peters Canyon south of Harvard
Hooded Merganser	Peters Canyon Regional Park ( <i>also N. Rough-winged Swallow</i> )
American Bittern	Peters Canyon Regional Park ( <i>also Least Bittern</i> )
Ferruginous Hawk	El Toro
Hooded Warbler *	Aurora Park in Mission Viejo near Alicia & Marguerite Parkways, in ravine
Broad-billed Hummingbird *	NE edge of Mission Viejo Golf Course. Take Oso Pkwy east of I-5, turn left on Marguerite Prkwy, then a quick left on Via Angelina where you park at the end of the street. The bird frequents red-flowering eucalyptus at end of street & likes to rest in Brazilian Pepper at the end of chain link fence along creek. Bird is more often heard than seen; check all Ruby-crowned Kinglet calls.
Plumbeous Vireo	Maintenance yard of Casta del Sol Golf Course, Mission Viejo
Wilson's Warbler	Lion Country
Hammond's Flycatcher	Ridge Route & Moulton Parkway near Vieh Lake in Laguna Hills
Black-throated Gray Warbler	Serrano Creek
Scott's Oriole	Limestone Canyon ( <i>also Lawrence's Goldfinch</i> )
Lewis' Woodpecker	Near gate at Blackstar Canyon
Eastern Phoebe	1-2 miles south of #405 Frwy. on #133 near the lake. Caution: Dangerous road!
Mountain Bluebird	Between Laguna Cyn Rd. & #133, just south of #405 Frwy.
Vesper Sparrow	Just north of "Laguna Lake"
Brown Creeper	Irvine Regional Park
Red-naped Sapsucker	O'Neill Regional Park upper mesa area
Northern Saw-whet Owl	Way up Silverado Canyon
Costa's Hummingbird	Westminster Memorial Park
Thayer's Gull *	In gull flock along Santa Ana River north of Lincoln Also 4 - 1 <sup>st</sup> year birds in gull flock at Doheny Beach State Park
Royal Tern	½ mile off Balboa Pier in the Pacific Ocean
Band-tailed Pigeon	Sycamore tree on west side of Baker St near corner of Santa Clara, SA
Common Goldeneye	Santa Ana River Mouth
Eurasian Wigeon	Santa Ana River south of Memory Lane, north of dam
Peregrine Falcon	Seal Beach NWR
Merlin	Thornton Park, north of Segerstrom, west of Bristol, in Santa Ana
