In less than one month as many whales, dolphins and other cetaceans die from entanglements with active fishing gear as die annually in all the cetacean hunts worldwide. Capt. Dave, a dynamic, popular speaker & local authority on dolphins and whales, will show us a simple solution to this problem that could prevent the majority of entanglements of whales off California. He will tell us how the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the organization in charge of protecting whales and dolphins in the United States, could do more to stop the problems.

Capt. Dave will also show us "some of the most beautiful whale footage" he has ever seen or filmed. Join us to learn more about life in So Cal's ocean.
