Birding Ethics and Behavior Standards for
Junior Naturalists

Promote the welfare of birds and their environment:

Stay behind the group leader at all times

Stay on the trail

Be quiet on the trail

Do not disturb any wildlife, especially nesting birds or birds at feeding sites

Use bird call devices with extreme caution, and obey your adult leader's instructions and the regulations of the site you visit regarding their use

Respect the law and the rights of others:

Be courteous to others; especially be sensitive about noise on camping trips

Do not enter private property without the owner's express permission

Respect the skills and interests of your fellow naturalists

Freely share your knowledge and experience, especially with beginners

Be a good example to others in the group
