You will need the following information to complete the report:

- Wing Tag Number (any corresponding symbol such as a dot ●)
- Wing Tag Color
- Wing Tag is on the Right or Left Wing
- Date and location of bird sighting
- Other notable information (e.g., alive/dead) as requested Such as: White wing tag, 1A dot, on right (as shown) →
