The following species are introduced and compared with their sound-alikes from Learning California Bird Sounds and occasionally other workshops in this series:

GROUP 1: Phainopepla, Canyon Wren, Rock Wren, Cactus Wren, Northern Cardinal, Pyrrhuloxia, Scott's Oriole.

GROUP 2: Canyon Towhee, Abert's Towhee, Spotted Towhee (desert forms), Verdin, Black-tailed Gnatcatcher, Bronzed Cowbird, Great-tailed Grackle.

GROUP 3: Summer Tanager, Crissal Thrasher, Curve-billed Thrasher, Bendire's Thrasher, LeConte's Thrasher, Sage Thrasher.

<u>GROUP 4</u>: Ladder-backed Woodpecker, Gila Woodpecker, Gilded Flicker, Gambel's Quail, Greater Sage-Grouse, Gunnison Sage-Grouse, Ring-necked Pheasant, Scaled Quail, Chukar.

GROUP 5: Brown-crested Flycatcher, Dusky-capped Flycatcher, Northern Beardless-Tyrranulet, Vermilion Flycatcher, Willow Flycatcher, Horned Lark, Lucy's Warbler.

GROUP 6: Bell's Sparrow, Sagebrush Sparrow, Black-throated Sparrow, Vesper Sparrow, Botteri's Sparrow, Cassin's Sparrow, Brewer's Sparrow.

GROUP 7: Rufous-winged Sparrow, Rufous-crowned Sparrow, Lark Sparrow, Bell's Vireo, Black-chinned Hummingbird, Costa's Hummingbird.

GROUP 8: Chihuahuan Raven, Black-billed Magpie, Western Scrub-Jay (desert forms), Burrowing Owl, Elf Owl, Short-eared Owl, Long-eared Owl.

GROUP 9: Common Ground-Dove, Inca Dove, White-winged Dove, Eurasian Collared-Dove, Lesser Nighthawk, Common Nighthawk, Common Poorwill.
