Minimize single use plastics	Use reusable grocery bags
	Stop/reduce the use of zipper storage bags
	Avoid plastic cutlery
Decrease water use	Use a shower bucket to collect cold water while the shower  is bestimated and the content to a tribute all after flowing.
	is heating up; add the contents to a toilet tank after flushing
	Switch your shower to a low flow shower  Bun your dishwasher and washing machine only when full

Reduce packaging	<ul> <li>Don't forget your reusable bags!</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Buy produce items loose, not packaged, and bag them in</li> </ul>
	your own reusable bags
	Buy in bulk
Be "eco-smart" about prepared and to-go foods	<ul> <li>Decline cutlery, plates, and napkins</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Avoid single-serve condiments</li> </ul>
	Plan picnics etc. with reusables
	Carry reusable containers for restaurant leftovers
	Separate and recycle anything you can!
Reduce energy use – in your house and in your car	Switch lightbulbs to LED
	Choose energy-efficient appliances  Change from sea to plactic on magnetic induction.
	<ul> <li>Change from gas to electric or magnetic induction appliances</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Change to a heat pump system for heat and A/C</li> </ul>
	Add insulation, seal cracks, install double-paned windows
	Carpool when possible and avoid backtracking
	Need a new car? Consider electric, plug-in hybrid, hybrid
Reuse your "trash"	Adapt items to new uses
	<ul> <li>Consider creative upcycling and crafts</li> </ul>
	Share with the needy
	<ul> <li>Give usable items to a local "Buy Nothing" group</li> </ul>
Garden in an eco-friendly way	Develop a waterwise garden
	Grow some of your own food
	<ul> <li>Begin composting or vermiculture</li> </ul>
