

The Sea and Sage Junior Naturalist Program is for teens who love birding and being out in nature. Under the supervision of adult Audubon naturalists, they participate in monthly field trips and stewardship projects from August to July of the following year. Junior Naturalists donate their time and talents in service to Sea and Sage Audubon and take field trips where they discover birds and explore unique habitats in Southern California. They are involved in both making suggestions as to where field trips will take place and in determining what we will do that year.

Minimum Requirements:

- 1. Must have a demonstrated interest in birds (attended Audubon camp, completed Scout birding badge, or other equivalent experience with support of teacher recommendation)
- 2. Must be 13 or older by Sept 1st and/or enrolled in 8th grade or higher grades
- 3. Maximum age is 18 or upon graduation from high school
- 4. Must maintain current membership in Audubon as an individual or family Deadline to submit an application is September 1st.
